ABOUT THE PROJECT

WOODCircle aims to cope with the **twin transition** (circular & digital) of the **wood and furniture** (W&F) industry, by focusing on the upskilling of the labour force with the help of a new profile: a **Circular and Sustainable Woodworker through dual vocational training.**

OBJECTIVES

- Upskilling today's W&F labor force to create circular and sustainable woodworkers for tomorrow
- **Supporting the W&F industry** in facing the challenges linked to ongoing twin transition
- Create an innovative training tool, flexible, online, and free of charge

ACTIVITIES

- WOODcircle will firstly identify the circular and sustainable skills and competences needed by people actively working in the wood and furniture sectors.
- A training curriculum will then be designed in order to meet the specific needs, and a training course will be developed (in 5 European languages, EQF level 4 and 1 ECVET credit / 25 h).
- Finally this course will be published on an open and free online platform.
- The **course will be validated** through a **test phase** involving **125 young people** (piloting phase), **20** of whom will participate in a 5 day **dual training journey to Hungary.**
